Union Minister Dr. Win Myat Aye separately receives Representatives from UNHCR and UNFPA

Dr. Win Myat Aye, Union Minister for Social Welfare, Relief and Resettlement, received Mr. Giuseppe de Vincentiis, Representative of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) and Ms. Janet E. Jackson, Representative of the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) separately on afternoon of 18 January.

At the meeting with the Representative of UNHCR, the Union Minister discussed about the cooperation with relevant ministries for repatriation and resettlement, preparation of two repatriation camps and temporary camp which is ready to live for displaced people, visit and access the news to media and diplomats to Rakhine State. At the meeting with the representative of UNFPA, the Union Minister discussed the preparation of repatriation process to commence on 23 January, to promote the process of issuing of National Verification Card (NVC).

Dr. Aye Maung, a parliament representative elected from Ann township constituency, who has been charged under the Unlawful Association Law for giving a talk at a literature session in Yathedaung, Rakhine State to mark the 233rd anniversary of the fall of the Rakhine Kingdom in Yathedaung Monday, has been remanded in custody in Sittway Prison.

Charges were filed on Tuesday evening at the Yathedaung Police Station against Dr. Aye Maung under Section 17 (1) of the Unlawful Association Law.
