3,000 issued NVC and NID cards in Maungtaw Township

An official from Rakhine State Immigration and Population Department said nearly 3,000 people from ShweZar Village, Maungtaw Township, Rakhine State have been issued National Verification Cards (NVCs) and technology-based National Electronic IDs (NIDs), a pilot programme.

Although the staff from the Ministry of Labour, Immigration and Population is continuing the process of issuing NVCs and NIDs in Zedipyin Village, ShweZar Village Tract, Maungtaw Township, the number of people making NVCs and NIDs are declining. ShweZar Village tract containing 12 Muslim villages is close to Maungtaw Township.

Mro national killed in Maungtaw Township
