State Counsellor holds talks with Advisory Board of Committee for Implementation of Recommendations on Rakhine State

Naypyitaw, April 02

State Counsellor and Union Minister for Foreign Affairs Daw Aung San SuuKyí received Dr.SurakiartSathirathai, Chairman of the Advisory Board of the Committee for Implementation of Recommendations on Rakhine State, and its members on 2 April at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Nay Pyi Taw.

The Chairman explained about the activities and the work plan of the Advisory Board. They exchanged views on matters related to the implementation of the preliminary recommendations of the Advisory Board, the ways and means to address the challenges and development in Rakhine State.

This was the second meeting between the State Counsellor and the Advisory Board since its inception.

Union Minister for Social Welfare, Relief and Resettlement Dr. Win Myat Aye and the Advisory Board of the Committee for Implementation of the Recommendations on Rakhine State held talks on 2 April in Nay Pyi Taw over several issues for Rakhine State.

They discussed matters related to inclusive talks, humanitarian aid, and access to information, repatriation, resettlement and rehabilitation.They also reviewed pragmatic measures taken for involvement of UN agencies in rehabilitation and development issues in Rakhine State, participation of youth volunteers and providing



aid to the local people through the World Food Programme and Red Cross Movement.

The meeting also highlighted the construction of infrastructures, health care programme, education, free movement, national scrutinisation process, media coverage, closing of IDP camps opened in 2012, a pilot project in Rakhine State joining hands with the ASEAN community, promoting humanitarian assistance and rehabilitation and resettlement in Rakhine State with the help of UN agencies and partner countries and contribution of expertise and businesses from Thailand.

Rakhine State Chief Minister meets Turkish Ambassador

Rakhine State Chief Minister U NyiPu met with Ambassador of Turkey to Myanmar Mr. Kerem Divanlioglu and party on 2 April at the State Chief Minister meeting hall in Sittway.

The Turkish ambassador said that they would continue to help in the challenges occurring in Rakhine State and to learn of the present situation.

The Chief Minister replied that works were being conducted for resettlement, receiving (of returnees), long term development and stability. Reception centres were prepared and readied as directed by the State Counsellor. More than six hundred houses were already constructed in Hla Pho Khaung Transit camp. After a temporarily stay in the transit camp, the returnees will be settled in their original place or a place nearest to the original place. Income generation measures are also arranged. A committee organized by Deputy Minister for Ministry of State Counsellor's Office has been formed to receive and resettle returnees.
