Returnses from Bangladesh resettled in accordance with bilateral agreement

Sittway, May 31

Union Minister for Social Welfare, Relief and Resettlement Dr. Win Myat Aye, Rakhine State Chief Minister U NyiPu and Rakhine State Minister U AungKyawZan supervised works for resettlement of the displaced people who returned from Bangladesh voluntarily earlier this week at the Hla Pho Khaung Transit Centre in Maungtaw Township on 31 May 2018.

At the transit centre, the Union Minister and party inspected the issuance of the National Verification card to returnees, and the citizenship scrutiny carried out by the Ministry of Labour, Immigration and Population. The National Verification Card is the first step in applying for citizenship.

Out of 62 returnees at the Hla Pho Khaung Transit Centre, 10 had left to their original places of residence on their own arrangements. The remaining 52 returnees were systematically handed over to the administrators of their respective villagers and the process was documented.
