104 people, a broken boat found stranded at seashore in Yathedaung

Naypyitaw, June 11

Security forces inspected the seashore between Agnumaw and Donpike villages in Yathedaung Township on 11 June and found 104 people including 44 men and 60 women and a broken motorized boat. All Islamic people were transported to Ngakhuya Reception Centre in the evening and received thescrutinization by the Immigration and National Registration Department.
