### **Discussion on the socio-economic development activities in Rakhine State**

Naypyitaw July 25

Union Minister for Ministry of Labour, Immigration and Population U TheinSwe received the Ambassador of Norway to Myanmar H.E Ms. Tone Tinnes at the meeting hall of Ministry of Labour, Immigration and Population on 24 July.

During the meeting, they openly discussed ongoing operations relating to the MoU signed between the Myanmar government, UNHCR and UNDP on the repatriation of returnees from Bangladesh, the field visit to Rakhine State of the representatives from UNDP and UNHCR, programs regarding to education, socio-economic development in Rakhine State, ongoing implementation of Advisory Board of the Committee for Implementation of Recommendations on Rakhine State, issuing national verification cards (NVCs) in regions and states including Rakhine State, the progress on issuing national verification cards with Norwegian Refugee Council and long-term collaboration, it is learnt.

and coexistence between communities. In the afternoon, the 17-member delegation visited the Ngakhuya Reception Centre and witnessed the assistance provided to the returnees at the centre and saw the process of issuing National Verification Cards to the returnees.
