Union Minister Dr. Win Myat Ayereceives UNSG's Special Envoy on Myanmar
Naypyitaw October 12

Union Minister Dr. Win Myat Aye received a delegation led by United Nations Secretary General's Special Envoy on Myanmar Ms. Christine SchranerBurgener at the Ministry in Nay Pyi Taw yesterday.

During the meeting, national reconciliation and internal peace, performances of Implementation Committee on the Recommendations of the Advisory Commission on Rakhine State, conditions of Internally Displaced People (IDP) camps being closed and to be closed along with drawing up strategies for resettlement, cooperation with UN organizations, readiness of infrastructures for repatriation, issues about international aid, MoU signed between United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) and issues about human rights and repatriation were discussed.
