Vice President U Myint Swe receives Independent Commission of Enquiry Naypyitaw October 6

Vice President U Myint Swe received the Independent Commission of Enquiry and members led by Ambassador H.E. Rosario Manalo at the Envoys Hall of the Presidential Palace yesterday.

At the meeting, matters relating to commission's field visit and action taken, activities of ARSA terrorist group, status of preparations made to receive returnees, status of cooperation with UNDP and UNHCR, works conducted by the State for Rakhine State stability and development and future works were discussed and views exchanged.

Union Minister Dr. Win Myat Aye meets with Vice-President of ICRC Naypyitaw October 5

Union Minister Dr. Win Myat Aye held talks with Mr. Gilles Carbonnier, Vice-President of the International Committee of the Red Cross, at the head of the ICRC in Geneva.

During the meeting, he acknowledged the cooperation of the ICRC in Rakhine State through its Red Cross Movement after the terrorist attacks. He also said that Myanmar is carrying out development works in Rakhine State in accordance with the policy of seeking solutions through negotiations and discussions leading to coexistence between different communities. He also stressed the importance of ensuring transparency in cooperation with local people and local social organizations to gain better results.

ICRC's vice-president said he took pride in carrying out humanitarian activities in Myanmar, pledging that ICRC would continue its cooperation in giving aid to people



not only in Rakhine but also in Kachin and Shan and ICRC would continue its efforts for reducing landmine incidents in Myanmar.
