

## **PRESS RELEASE**

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Government of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar expresses its deep concern on the hydrogen bomb test conducted by the Democratic People's Republic of Korea on 6 January 2016.

The test is in violation of the relevant United Nations Security Council Resolutions and undermines the international non-proliferation regime and increases tension in the Korean Peninsula.

Myanmar attaches great importance to nuclear disarmament and non-proliferation of weapons of mass destruction. Also being a dedicated State Party of the Southeast Asia Nuclear Weapon-Free Zone (SEANWFZ) Treaty which aims to prevent the proliferation of nuclear weapons, Myanmar is working vigorously towards a world free of nuclear weapons. In this regard, Myanmar urges the Democratic People's Republic of Korea to comply with the United Nations Security Council resolutions.
